How it works

Qanik is a sweet-toothed reindeer from the North who helps children discover the secrets of gelato through his friends' adventures. These friends travel from all over the world to bring Qanik bizarre gifts of strange shapes and aromas, making it possible to offer his reindeer friends a truly unique food: sweet, cool, sometimes creamy, other times a bit coarse, sometimes hard, but always delicious and colorful!

Objectives:

Stimulate creativity, foster the development of the sense of touch and manual abilities, and inspire a yearning for discovery,

JOURNEY THROUGHTIME WITH GELATO

How it works

Together with instructors from Gelato University, the students will reconstruct sorbet and gelato recipes developed between ancient times and the Renaissance. Children will participate in the preparation of these ancient recipes. At the end of the workshop, gelato tasting.

Objectives:

Dive into gelato history, rediscovering recipes from the Renaissance and far beyond.

MANAGING THE CRYSTAL

How it works

Working as gelato apprentices, the students will perform two experiments together with Gelato University instructors. First, they will observe the behavior of sugar dissolved in water at low temperatures. Furthermore, they will find out the effects of salt mixed with ice.

Objectives:

Analyze the role and effects of sugar and water in gelato.

Duration: 1 h 30 min.

GELATO ARTISAN FOR A DAY

How it works

During the workshop the students will learn how to transform fresh fruit into excellent gelato. After learning the production steps, they will discover how to balance recipes, and will earn the chance to become official assistants to the Gelato University instructors, helping them to make gelato.

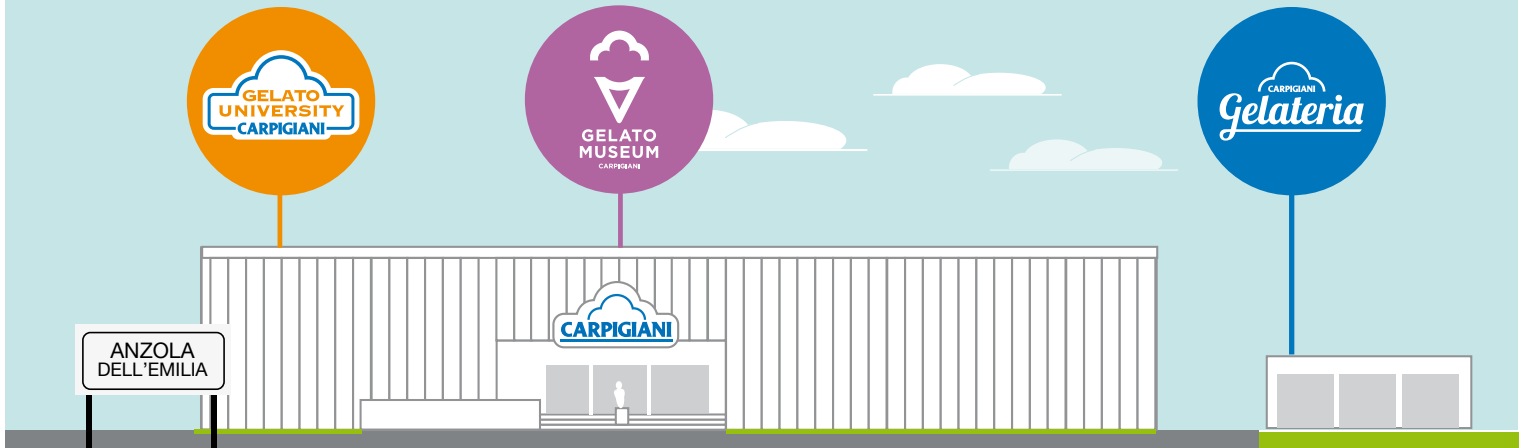
Objectives:

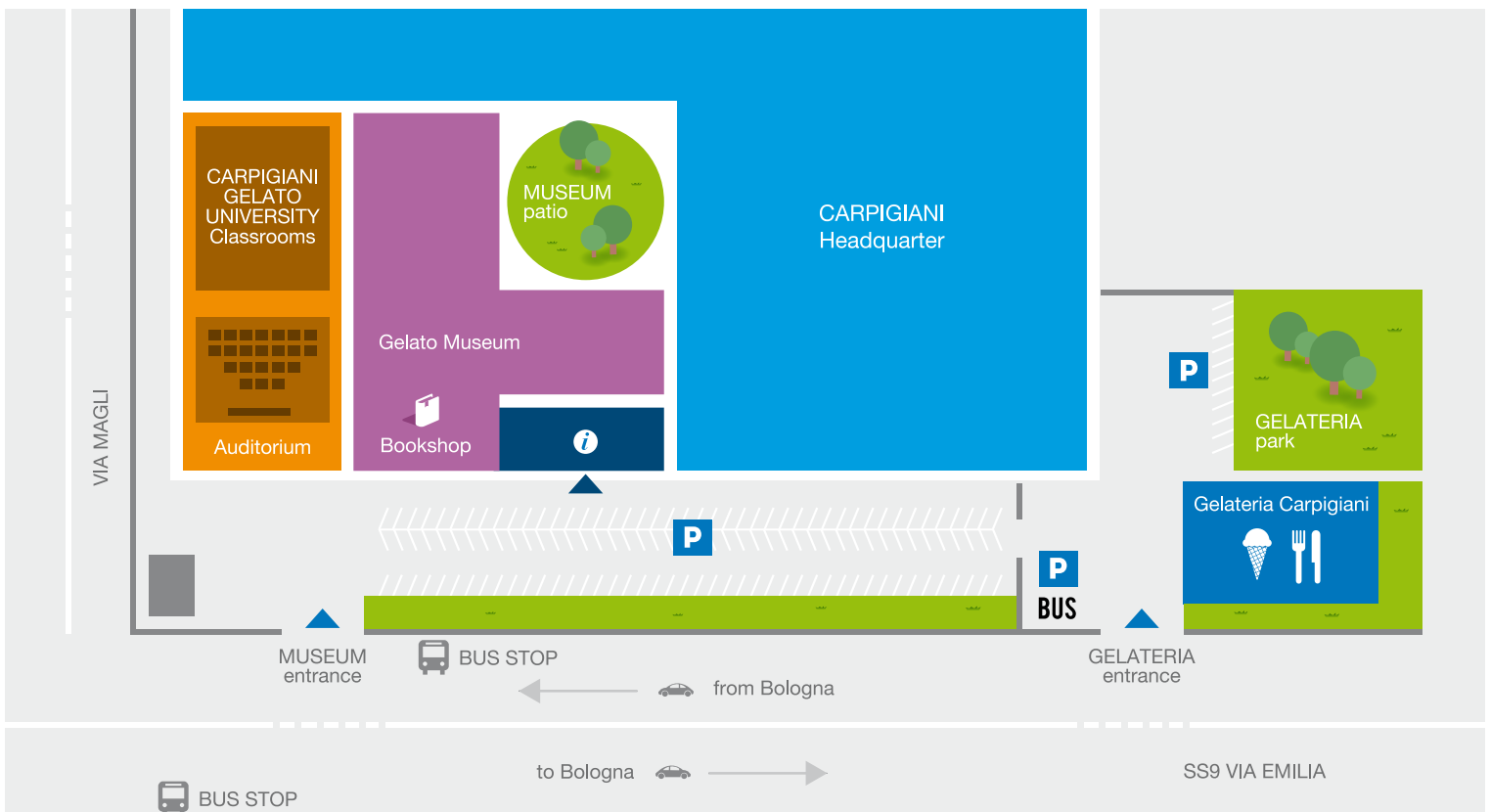

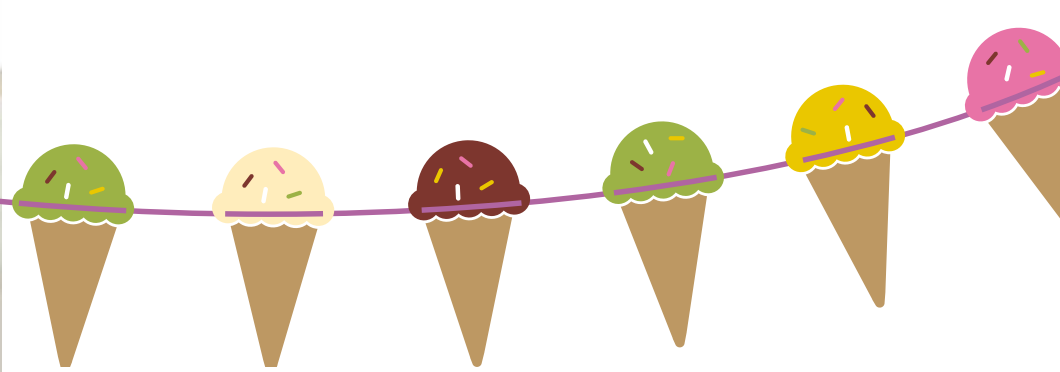

Environmental Archeological Museum

The Environmental Archeological Museum is part of a network of museums in the Terre D'Acqua communities focused on ancient villages and their connections with the countryside and habitats of the past in the large area between the Samoggia and Panaro rivers. Inaugurated in 2011, the museum in Anzola dell'Emilia features the archeological digs carried out in the 1990s and studies the relationship also with European, Mediterranean, and Near Eastern realities in the Bronze Age.

Ca' La Ghironda
